There's a fire blanket fixed on the cabinet next to the stove. The fire extinguisher and first aid kit are in the drawers to the right of the stove in the kitchen.


Check-in

CHECK-IN TIME: 4.00 PM

We'll text you with the door lock code 24 hours ahead – it will generally be the last 4 digits of the cellphone number associated with the booking. Access is via the side door. In case of difficulty, reach out to us for the code for the manual lockbox located on the railing next to the side door.

Note: There is a motion sensitive light over the side door. There are ring cameras over every door - we can see who enters and leaves the property.



HEATING & AIR CONDITIONING

The ground and second floor are heated by cast iron radiators. The thermostat is on the foyer wall on the ground floor.



appliances & Electronics

AIR CONDITIONING



Use the Eco mode at Auto Fan for cooling to your desired room temperature.

Use the Temperature increase +/ decrease - pads to set the temperature between 64 °F and 86 °F.

If the air conditioner is off and turned on while set to Cool, or turned on from a fan to a Cool setting, it may take 3 minutes for the compressor to start.

TVs & ROKUs

The ground floor and master bedroom each have a TV equipped with a Roku for streaming TV.

WASHER & DRYER

The ground floor has a washer and dryer. We'll provide a starter set of laundry detergent, spot remover and dryer sheets.

Trash & Recycling

Please put trash and recycling in the bin outside in the side yard under the kitchen window.

appliances & Electronics cont.

SMART HOME FEATURES

The lights on the front and side porches turn on from sunset to 11pm. To turn this off, the switches are behind the switch guards inside the house.

After 11pm, the porch lights will turn on a dim setting for 10 minutes when motion is detected. The table lamp in the foyer and the light at the top of the stairs are activated by a motion sensor. With motion between 8am and 11pm, they turn on brightly. After 11pm, they turn on dimly.



Smart Lighting works when the light switches covered by switch guards are turned on. If turned off, please turn them back on when you leave.

appliances & Electronics cont.

The kitchen, music room, bedrooms, back porch and office all have Alexa smart speakers which will play your choice of music on demand. If you prefer, Alexa can be disabled by pressing the microphone button until Alexa glows red. If you disable Alexa, please return to active before you leave by pressing the microphone button again.

BY CAR


There are 2 parking spaces in the driveway next to the house. There is no parking in front of the house but there is available parking on the other side of the street.

BY BUS

The bus service is operated by the <u>Potomac</u> <u>Valley Transit Authority</u>.



There are stops for the yellow, red and blue lines within a few minutes walk. You can request special stops along most routes. Romney also has a "Ready Ride" service, providing taxi-style pickup anywhere in the Romney service area. Call 304.257.1414 for these services.

places to see

FORT MILL RIDGE CIVIL

WAR TRENCHES

The Fort Mill Ridge trenches are believed to be the best preserved battle trenches from the Civil War. The trenches are located 3 miles SW of Romney on Rt 50. Free.

THE DAVIS HISTORY HOUSE

Built in 1798, only log house still on its original lot in Romney. The Davis family was an example of the "brother against brother" in the Civil War. The house has been converted into a Civil War museum. Free.

ICE MOUNTAIN PRESERVE

In cooler months, dense, cold air sinks deep into the talus, and ice masses form inside. As the weather warms up, the cooler air flows out of vents among the rocks at the bottom. Rare plants like its unusual climate. Free.

DENTS RUN COVERED

<u>BRIDGE</u>

Built in 1889, this 13 ft wide, 40 ft long bridge covers Dent's Run. Beautifully preserved and peaceful. Nearby parking lot for convenience. Free.

places for kids

MOUNTAIN TRAIL RIDES

Includes horseback riding, a petting zoo, gemstone mining and an adventure cave. It also has a gift shop and has guided field trips. In Davis, WV about 1 hour from Romney. Paid.

EXPLORE ART & CLAY

Located in Front Royal, VA, here you can learn how to make pottery, or paint a pre-made piece. You can also pick up a DIY kit to complete at home, and bring it back to the store for firing. Paid.

BROADFORD LAKE PARK

The park offers a lake, picnic and beach areas, volleyball, basketball, boat launch, boat and pavilion rentals. It has at least 3 playgrounds. Located in Oakland MD. Free to visit.

OLD MCDONALD'S

PUMPKIN PATCH & CORN

<u>MAZE</u>

Kids Activities such as Hay Rides, Tube Slides, playground and jump pads. Only open for 6 weeks in the Fall, so call ahead. Located in Inwood. Paid.

POTOMAC EAGLE

RAILROAD

Beautiful historic and scenic train rides .With a rich history dating back to 1875, they deliver an experience you will never forget. If you're luck you may see nesting bald eagles! Paid. <u>TRANS-ALLEGANY LUNATIC</u>

<u>ASYLUM</u>

Re-opening for tours in March 2024, offers guided historical and paranormal tours. Also offers overnight ghost hunts a couple of times per month. Located in Weaton WV, Paid.

HAMPSHIRE PARK

11 acres with 7 pavilions, large BBQ pit, 4 tennis courts, basketball court, sports field, sand volleyball court, Playground equipment, restrooms & shower house. Free to visit.

TROUGH GENERAL STORE & CANOE RENTAL

Offers seasonal canoe rental, shuttle service and a general store. The shuttle takes you south 12 miles, and you canoe back to the store going through the trough. Paid.

Breweries & Wineries

DIG DEEP BREWING

Dig Deep Brewing Company, located in the historic Footer Dye Works Building, was started in Cumberland, MD in 2017. They provide live music and food trucks from around the area. Paid.

POTOMAC HIGHLANDS WINERY

The winery and vineyard are located between Keyser and Burlington, WV. The shale in the soil gives this region a similar "terroir" to that of Germany although the climate is drier. Paid.

CHARIS WINERY

Produces a variety of grape wines such as Chancellor, Nebbiolo, Pinot Noir and white wines like Pinot Grigio, Vidal Blanc, etc. and fruit wines like Peach, Cranberry, Blueberry, Strawberry and more. Cumberland, MD. Paid.

GLEN MANOR WINERY

Located in Front Royal, VA situated on a western flank of the Blue Ridge Mountains. The surrounding mountains, ranging between 1400 and 3400 feet in elevation, form a Glen which gives the vineyards a unique environment. Paid.

Two floors filled with a variety of crafts, including hand-blown glass, pottery, woodcrafts, jewelry, fiber crafts, ornaments, books, cards & soaps, as well as original art & prints– all by WV artists & artisans. Free.

Hiking

NATHANIEL MOUNTAIN

This 10,700 acre Wildlife Management Area offers a network of 11.5 miles of dirt road trails. It's about 30 minutes to Nathaniel Mountain Public Hunting Rd.

FORT MILL RIDGE

This 232 acre WMA has a 2.7-mile out-andback trail taking an average of 1 h 21 min to complete. It's about 5 minutes to 29720 Northwestern Pike.

Watersports

There are many opportunities detailed at the <u>WV Dept Of Natural Resources website</u>.

WHITE HORSE MOUNTAIN

This is a 1,765 million acre Wildlife Management Area. At South Branch Potomac River you can fish for largemouth/smallmouth bass, bluegill, channel catfish, muskellunge, walleye. Hunting includes deer, turkey, bear

squirrel, rabbit, grouse, dove, and woodcock. It's about 20 minutes to the entrance Swisher Hollow Rd.

FORT MILL RIDGE

This is a 232 acre Wildlife Management Area. At South Branch River you can fish for rock and smallmouth bass, channel catfish, panfish. Hunting includes deer, turkey, waterfowl, and squirrel. It's about 5 minutes away at 29720 Northwestern Tpk.
